## Network Help Desk and Support Technician

BrainMill AB, the company managing Chalmers Studentbostäder's network, is looking to grow its team which operate and enhance the network and related services.

The positions are hourly based with relatively flexible schedules and you will be part of a team which share the responsibilities with you. On-boarding and initial training to make you familiarized with the role will be provided.

In this role you will be the face of the company as you provide the first line of support, meaning assisting users through the service desk function and helping them troubleshoot and solve the problems on their own, and when that fails, troubleshoot the case in the field. It also means responding to incidents such as fiber breaks, power outages, crashing hardware and software. Your problem-solving skill will be put to the test as you have to address the variety of issues that can come up.

The role requires that you are based in Gothenburg in order to have quick access to the sites.

### Job Responsibilities

- Manage the service desk
  - Respond to queries via the service desk web portal
  - Guide customers through troubleshooting and suggest best remedy
  - Schedule and perform occasional home visits to diagnose cable faults
  - Escalate unresolved issues to next support level
- Respond to incidents such as fiber breaks, power outages, crashing hardware and software
- Continuously apply troubleshooting flow chart diagrams on the work and make improvements
- Manage customer information documents
- Update FAQ
- Update customer self-help guides and tutorials

## Software Developer

The company BrainMill AB is looking for additional people to grow its team of people with development skills.

The positions are hourly based with flexible schedules, with an expectation of working at least 8 hours per week. You will be responsible for executing your tasks efficiently and in an effective manner. On-boarding and initial training to make you familiarized with the role will be provided.

In this role you will be working on development tasks related to both the Internet Service Provider business of BrainMill and related activities, as well as other activities related to other businesses. The scope of development activities ahead of you is wide ranging and your ingenuity will be put to the test. You will work in a team with other developers, but you will own and be responsible for your own tasks.

We prefer if you are based in either Gothenburg or Lund, but exceptions are possible.

- Produce clean, efficient code based on good software development practices
- Integrate software components with third-party programs
- Document software architecture and components
- Work with automated build system
- Packaging software for deployment

- Work independently as well as in team
